Kelp-ER

Made from fresh bull kelp (*Durvilleau Potatorum*) stem, collected sustainably off the west coast of Tasmania, Kelp-ER can be applied as a foliar spray over all turf species and garden plants including native plants.

Kelp-ER increases resistance to pests, frost and disease, promotes natural healthy growth, stimulates root development and releases locked up nutrients. It contains a host of minerals, vitamins, trace elements, natural growth hormones, Cytokins, Betaines and Auxins in natural form.

It is sprayer friendly - best results are obtained by regular applications as part of a Lawn Pride turf care program.

Spraying is recommended early morning or late evening preferably out of the heat of the day. As with most liquid products, it deserves a shake well before use and to be stored out of direct sunlight in a cool area.

Kelp-ER is available in a 2L Hose-on pack and a 5L concentrate.

Application

Directions for use: Apply in the cool hours of the day.
- Not required to be watered in after application.

Refilling 2L Hose On

Add 200mL of concentrate Kelp-ER to 2L Hose On bottle.
Fill the remainder of Hose On bottle with clean water.
Treats 200m².

Concentrate Spraying

Mix 100mL with 6-10L of clean water.
Treats 100m².

Watering Can

Add 2-4mL to 9L of clean water.
Diluted mixture will cover approximately 2-4m².

For Best Results

- New Lawns. Apply every 7 to 10 days whilst establishing.
- Lawns. Apply every 2-4 weeks as part of a maintenance schedule.
- Suitable for pre and post turf renovation.
